

## Studies in Language Sciences Submission Rules

1. SLS is open to papers in all areas of language sciences.
2. Members of the Japanese Society for Language Sciences have the right to submit papers. In co-authored papers, at least one member must be included as an author.
3. The language of the manuscripts must be either English or Japanese.
4. Submissions are welcomed at any time and go through the established peer-review process.
5. Submissions must be unpublished work.
6. Manuscripts being considered for publication or under review elsewhere cannot be submitted.
7. In principle, the authors should follow the latest guidelines.
8. The Editorial Board's Managing Editors will make final decisions on the acceptance or rejection of a submitted paper.
9. In principle, the authors will be allowed to proofread their manuscripts only once. Corrections should be limited to typographical errors, and no changes to the content should be permitted.
10. No publication costs will be charged to authors. No royalties will be paid to authors for the publication of submitted papers.
11. There are two types of papers: full papers and short papers. Full papers will usually be reviewed (2-3 months), and short papers will be reviewed quickly (1 month) to determine acceptance or rejection. If necessary, authors will consider the Editorial Board and the peer reviewers' opinions and submit a revised manuscript, and the decision will be made accordingly.

12. For full papers and short papers, no information about the names and affiliations of the authors will be presented in the manuscript.
13. The reviewers' names will not be disclosed to authors during or after the review of full and short papers.
14. The word count of full papers should be up to 8,000 words, including figures and tables, and include an abstract of up to 400 words. The word limit for a full paper in Japanese is 18,000 characters. Supplemental material may be included if necessary. Reference lists are not included in the word count.
15. Short papers should be no more than 2,500 words in English, including figures and tables, and should include an abstract of no more than 200 words. Short papers in Japanese should be limited to 5,500 words. Supplemental material may be included if necessary. A list of references is not included in the word count.
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18. The copyright of the invited paper will be handled in the same way as #17.
19. Manuscripts should be submitted electronically via the URL provided on the conference website.
